We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2019-20 educational progress for the Big Bay de Noc School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2019-20 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Considering Big Bay de Noc School and its subgroups are performing well, Big Bay de Not School has NOT received a label this year for underperformance.

Throughout the 2019-2020 and 2018-19 school years, the Big Bay de Noc School Staff identified Mathematics as an area in need of growth across all grade levels. To help achieve this growth, we will continue to utilize the NWEA MAP testing in grades K-11 and continue to utilize a recently purchased math series. In addition, grades 2-9 adopted an initiative to link NWEA MAP results with an individualized, prescriptive program for each student in ELA and math through OdesseyWare and Khan Academy, which has been supported with a one-to-one Chromebook initiative. Big Bay de Noc School Staff also completed a Title I Schoolwide transition process, allowing broader use of our Title I funding to serve more students.

To continue school improvement, Big Bay de Noc School maintains a school improvement team, school improvement committees, and academic core teams. These teams actively work to develop, implement, and assess the School Improvement Plan and its goals. The School Improvement Plan is available through the school office.

Big Bay de Noc School follows the standards and benchmarks set in place by the State of Michigan. Parents play an integral role in our small community school. We have an active parent/teacher organization. We have several parents that serve on the School Improvement Team. Parents are encouraged and sometimes requested to spend time in the classroom with their children. There is an athletic booster club that raises funds to supplement our athletic programs. Our local American Legion regularly contributes to various school projects by raising funds with community service projects. We also boast of a senior drug free graduation party and class trip committee comprised solely of parents.

Advanced placement and dual-enrollment classes are available to our high school students through area colleges and universities along with Michigan Virtual High School. No students in the 2019-2020 school year opted to take advanced placement courses, which are offered through Michigan Virtual High School.

During the 2019/2020 school year, forty-three percent of graduating seniors received college credit through dual enrollment. The classes are offered mainly through Bay de Noc Community College and are taken online through the school network. Additionally, thirty percent of the graduating class participated in the Early Middle College Program.

With the help of parents, community, staff, and students, Big Bay de Noc School strives to continually offer a high quality educational program the students of the district.
